



Introduction and Mission

機構簡介 Introduction of CDAC

社區藥物教育輔導會於一九八五年成立,是一個致力推動藥物教育及健康教育的志願機構,本會成立初期有賴一群熱心關注青少年濫用藥物問題的家長及專業人士的支持;經過廿多年的不斷努力開拓及經驗累積,社區藥物教育輔導會現已發展成一個專業的社會服務機構,為社區提供適切的服務。

The Community Drug Advisory Council (CDAC) is a bilingual charitable organization founded in 1985 by a group of parents and professionals motivated by a concern about teen drug misuse in Hong Kong. With over 29 years of experience in drug education, CDAC continues to provide services for the whole Hong Kong Community.

使命 Mission

社區藥物教育輔導會的使命是預防濫用藥物問題及減低因濫用藥物問題帶來的禍害。 本會透過以下方法達成使命:

- 1) 提高社會對濫用藥物問題的關注;
- 2) 協助服務使用者發展社交技能,拒絕濫用藥物的引誘;
- 3) 向社會大眾推廣健康生活模式。

The Mission of the Community Drug Advisory Council is to prevent initiation into drug misuse and to minimize drug-related harm. We do this through:

- 1) Educational programs which raise community awareness;
- 2) Develop social skills; and
- 3) Promote healthy lifestyle choices.

Message from Chairperson

濫藥問題隱蔽化

作為香港預防濫藥教育及輔導的先行者,本會一直致力推動社會關注濫藥問題 - 特別是青少年的濫藥情況。去年,隨著濫藥行為持續隱蔽化,在政府探討社區驗毒的可行性前,本會已提前進行調查,搜集及發佈持份者意見,推動社會人士關注;並將調查結果供政府和業界人士參考。其後政府推出了「驗毒助康復計劃」諮詢,本會亦在立法會相關會議上提出意見,及在業界推動多方面的思考,倡導探討更廣泛的協作及儘早介入的方法。

Proactive in Tackling Hidden Drug Abuse

Being proactive in the prevention of drug abuse is the strategy CDAC adopted to counter drug abuse problem. Before the Narcotics Division began the consultation of Rescue Drug Testing Scheme to tackle the escalating hidden drug abuse problem last year, CDAC took initiatives to conduct a study to collect views of stakeholders to promote community awareness towards this agenda. We also proposed an earlier intervention on the supporting system collaborative through alternative approaches to the Legislative Council and HKCSS respectively. The attempt helped advance and extend the discussion in the exploration of effective intervention measures.

Advocacy for Early Intervention

In response to the structural factors contributing to drug abuse, CDAC focused on the early prevention through anti-drug education, as well as the support to schools and families. In the past year, we paid dedicated efforts in providing anti-drug education activities ranging from pre-school children to young people in the universities, rendering training support to teachers, extending collaboration with other agencies in supporting youth at-risk

We also provided tailored education activities though collaborating with youth organizations to young night drifters. The coverage of our services has also been extended to vulnerable target population such as ethnic minorities and sex minorities. In order to meet the training needs of drug related service workers including social workers, we developed tailored training programme, which was well received by the participants.

Service Strategy Review

In late 2014, with the purpose of enhancing agency development, three members of the Executive Committee, Agency Head and one frontline worker participated in a Strategic Planning Project which lasted for two months. A comprehensive review of our service strategy was conducted with the support of the Asian Charity Services. The output is expected to bring new momentum to the service in the coming year.

After serving the organization as the Chairperson of the Executive Committee for four years, I shall handover this position to my successor in December 2014. It brings me joy and satisfaction to witness ongoing development of the

機構主管報告

Agency Head's Report

香港吸毒情況持續隱蔽化,禁毒處檔案室的最新數字亦顯示,首次被呈報的吸毒者的「毒齡」中位數持續上升,由 2013 年的 4.6 年,上升至 2014 年首半年的 5.3 年。

與此同時,毒品仍不斷以各種新面 貌與不同渠道流入本地。根據前線社工 經驗所得,有些毒品以無色無味形態, 混入一般飲品及酒精中,被別有用心者 利用,陷人於危。而吸毒行為亦間接導 致性傳染病,例如愛滋病的風險增加。

對應社會情況,本會持續採取儘早 介入的預防教育,並擴展服務至各目標 社群。亦協同其他服務伙伴,深入社區, 提供輔導支援及服務。

According to the data provided by the Narcotics Division, the latest figures of the CRDA revealed a continued increase in the median drug abusing history of newly reported abusers, with an increase from 4.6 years in 2013 to 5.3 years in the first half of 2014. The drug abuse behaviour in Hong Kong has continued to be hidden and the situation worsened.

Our society has been more affluent than decades before when drug use was put under the rug. We have more resources to be put into the drug battle but the influx of new drugs never ends through various ways and means. The drug abuse behaviours also put people at risk of infecting sexually transmitted diseases, such as HIV/AIDS.

In response to the increasing complications of drug abuse, CDAC advocates early prevention and extension of intervention to targeted population. We continued collaborating with community service organizations last year to provide education and intensive counseling support so as to achieve greater effect and impact.

Student Service

In order to address different learning needs of students, we have developed

家長服務

除學校外,家長服務獲得不少業內 機構及社區團體轉介服務,內容均是按 個別需要設計,其中包括識別吸毒行為 及預防吸毒的家教支援。去年聯合國兒 童基金會資助專題項目「兒童及家長服 務計劃」,就以毒品和性為主題。 various types of programmes. The most popular programmes among lower form primary schools were "Drug Detective", "Judging Peer Influence", whereas for Upper Primary was "Say No to Drug Peers" and "Interactive Learning Workshop of Visiting Drug Information Centre". As for the Primary Six was "Free from Drug when I Grow Up". The "Say No to Drug Peers", "Self-image" and "Drug and Sex" were the programmes favoured by both students of secondary and vocational training schools. The current drug trend and identification of drug use behaviours were the topics the students of universities wished to know more about.

parenting skills and drug knowledge. With the support of UNICEF, a Project named "P.E.A.C.E. Pilot Drug and Sex Education for Children" was rendered for the children and parents in need.

Research and Publication

To tackle the hidden drug abuse problem, the Narcotics Division proposed "RESCUE Drug Testing Scheme" last year. In advance of the scheme to be opened for public consultation, we conducted a study to collect the views of major stakeholders towards the approach of community drug testing. The result was released through press conference and the publication of "A preliminary study on the issue of public view on Community Drugs Test (CDT)". The study promoted community awareness towards this measure. The report was submitted to the Narcotics Division suggesting a comprehensive consultation to collect the views of the public. At the same time, we appealed the Hong Kong government and relevant professionals to explore alternative measures as well as collaborative efforts with earlier intervention to tackle the drug problem. The views were presented to the Legislative Council and to drug related service practitioners via the Forum held by the Hong Kong Council of Social Services.



研究及出版

禁毒處去年推出「驗毒助康復」計 劃,諮詢公眾意見。本會在公眾諮詢 蘊釀之先,率先進行持份者意見調 查,製作成「初步探討不同持份者對 『社區為本驗毒計劃』意見調查報 告」,透過新聞發佈會促進公眾及業界 人士關注,以助積極參與討論,集思 廣益。結果並送禁毒處參考,以促進 有效的公眾諮詢。本會亦結合前線觀 察及專業經驗,剖析隱蔽化現象,透 過立法會會議向議員及公眾提出意 見;透過社會服務聯會會議,向業界 提出多元思考方向,協調業界力量, 積極建立其他可行的儘早介入方法。 調查報告亦已於2013年10月在澳門特 別行政區政府社會工作局主辦的「全 國藥物濫用防治研討會」上發表,以 供業界參考。

The report was also presented at "The 8th Mainland, Hong Kong and Macau Conference on Prevention of Substance Abuse" held by the Social Welfare Bureau of Macau SAR, October 2013.

There were plenty of education material and publication produced last year with adoption of evidence based practice principle in order to promote sharing of wisdom and to meet the various needs of community.

Development in Human Resource and Finance Management

With the support of the Executive Committee and the efforts of the newly established staff team, we completed the review on salary scale and post structure, updated the Staff Policy and reviewed finance management which collectively built up a solid ground for further service development.

Challenge and Outlook

Drug abuse problem has not disappeared from this city even though we have beat it hard. The alertness of the public towards the risk of drug harm declined after a period of intensive intervention, and the demand for service

挑戰與展望

毒品問題沒有隨着社會繁榮而減緩,而是如風如雨,滲入脆弱的社會處境內的人群中。但近年隨着潮水式的關注熱潮過後,社會的警覺性逐漸退卻,服務的需求迫切性也減低,如何守望有需要的社群,是未來艱鉅的挑戰。

隨着服務不斷發展,半山的辦公室 已不敷應用,交通不便,有礙服務使用 者使用服務及服務推展,故極需要在市 區建立服務基地。

近年不少具龐大常設資源的資助服 務機構、社區團體及院校亦加入競爭與 本會服務相關的資源。本會現正積極檢 視定位和策略,期望與時並進,發揮小 型機構對社會的效益。

gradually decreased last year. As a watch dog for the community, we have a lot of challenges ahead.

Our service has kept growing and extended territory wide. The office located in Mid-levels does not provide convenient access to service users. Neither does it accommodate staff members, nor support service development effectively. We are in pressing need for a service base to be set up in the urban area.

Since more resources were injected into beating drugs in recent years, numbers of service providers including government funded agencies, academic institutes and community organizations have actively joined in the competition of drug related funding. As a small NGO without government subvention, it is necessary for us to conduct review on the service position and strategy in order to optimize our contribution to the community.



2013-2014 年度服務場數統計


Number of Activities Completed in 2013-2014





